HISTORY OF RAINBOW BALL WEEKEND

Started in 2007, Rainbow Ball Weekend is larger than an event, it's a **3-day weekend of educational and social programming** for Maine lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning, intersex, asexual, two-spirit (LGBTQIA2S+), and allied 8th-12th grade students. Rainbow Ball Weekend builds community and connections, opens youth to a wider world of more acceptance and opportunity, and encourages educational aspirations.

Rainbow Ball Weekend's programming and activities directly address the isolation, underdeveloped aspirations, academic challenges, health risks and lack of hope faced by many Maine LGBTQIA2S+ youth. Each year, youth look forward to this weekend, which includes a safe prom, workshops, and leadership skill building. Rainbow Ball Weekend is a **direct youth suicide prevention intervention**, giving participants a year-long sense of community, hope, joy, and motivation to complete high school that is supported by ongoing regional youth-connecting events in the ensuing months.

At OUT Maine, we seek to change the very systems that serve diverse queer youth in all of their intersectional identities by creating more welcoming and affirming communities.

Our programming and training aims to **empower** youth in Maine's isolated and underresourced regions to be their most authentic selves; **support** their network of family and allies; and **educate** health care providers, educators, clergy and other professionals to better understand the needs of queer youth and provide affirmative support. OUT Maine's work gives everyone a role in building resilience and life skills necessary to lift up queer youth in our state.

In FY 2024 our work reached many youth and adults.

- 13,620 youth engagements.
- 3,998 professionals trained including teachers, medical professionals, and camp counselors.
- 760 school engagements.
